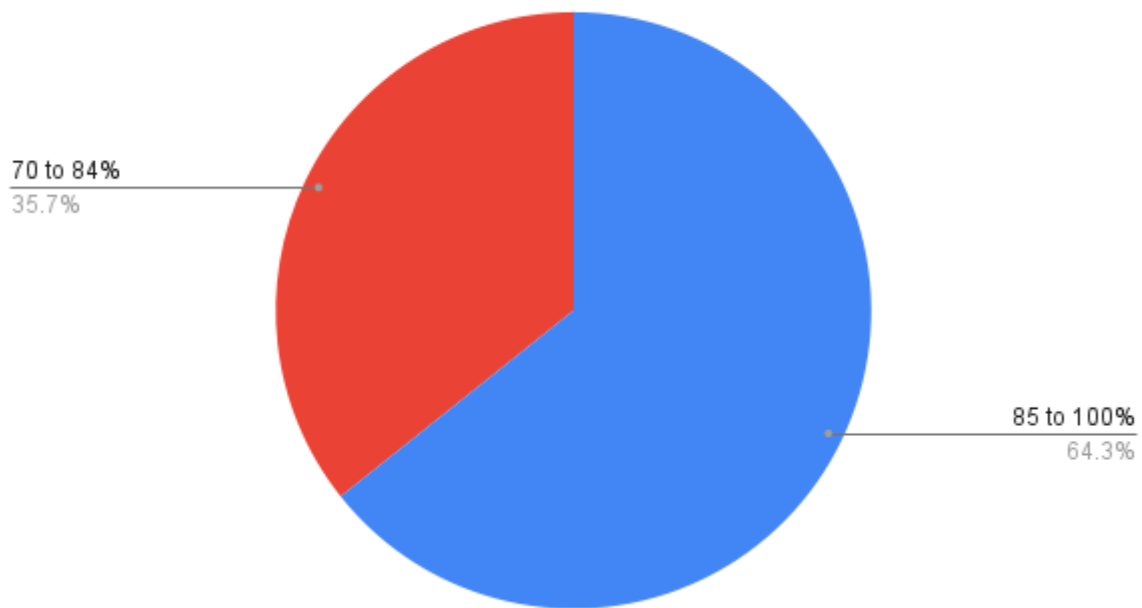

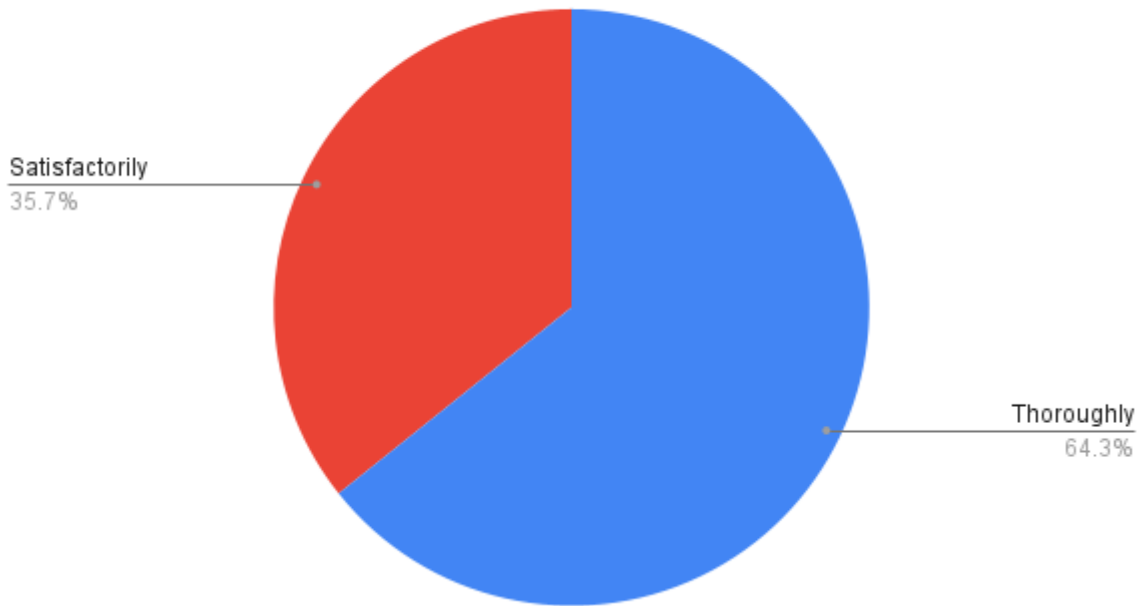
STUDENTS SATISFACTION SURVEY(SSS) GRAPHICAL ANALYSIS 2018-19

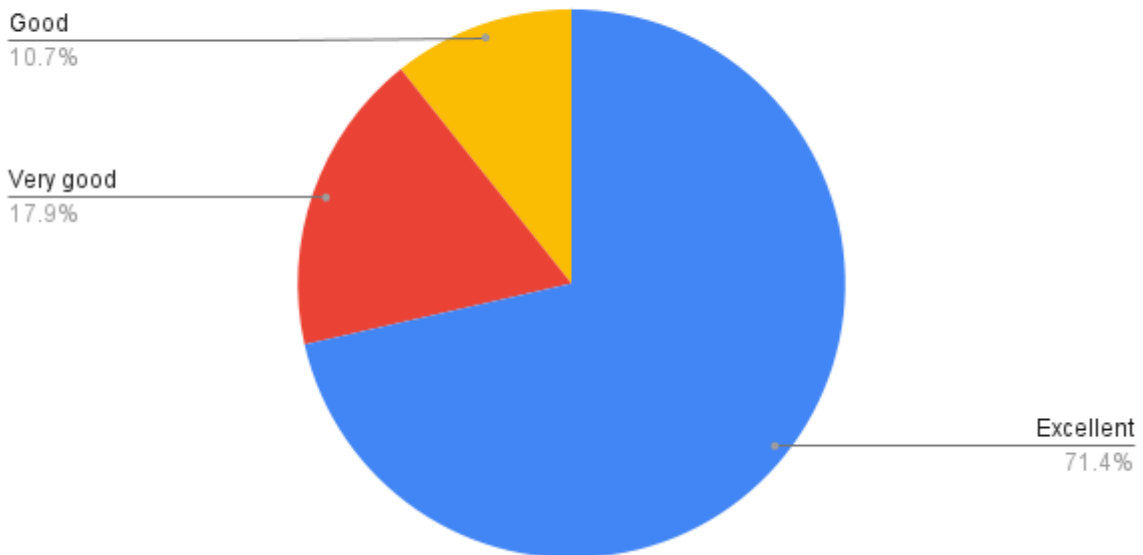
Count of 1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?



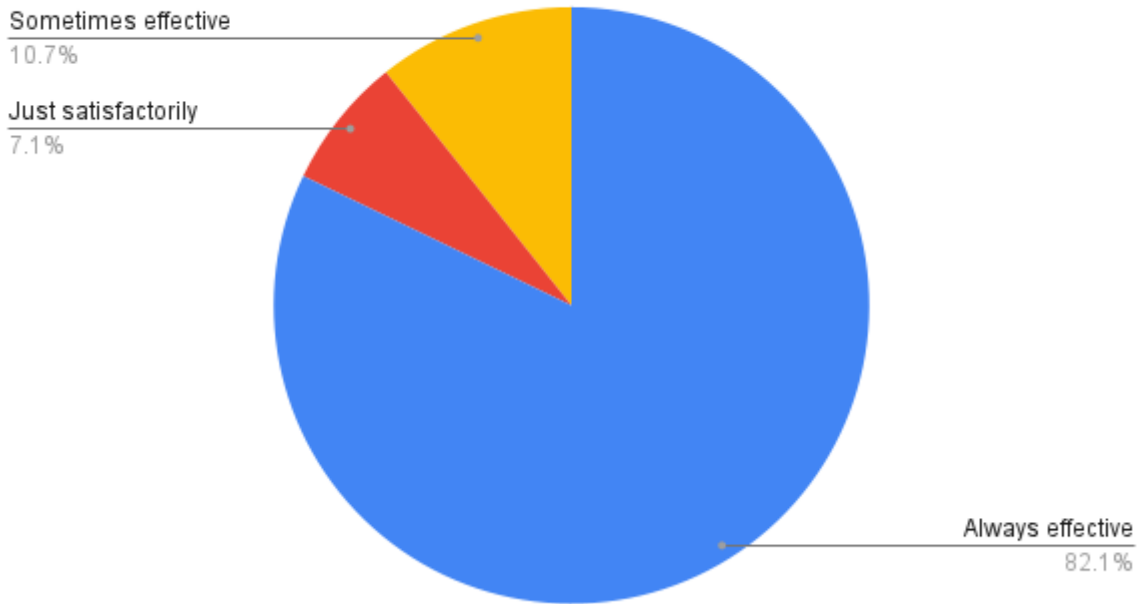
Count of 2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?



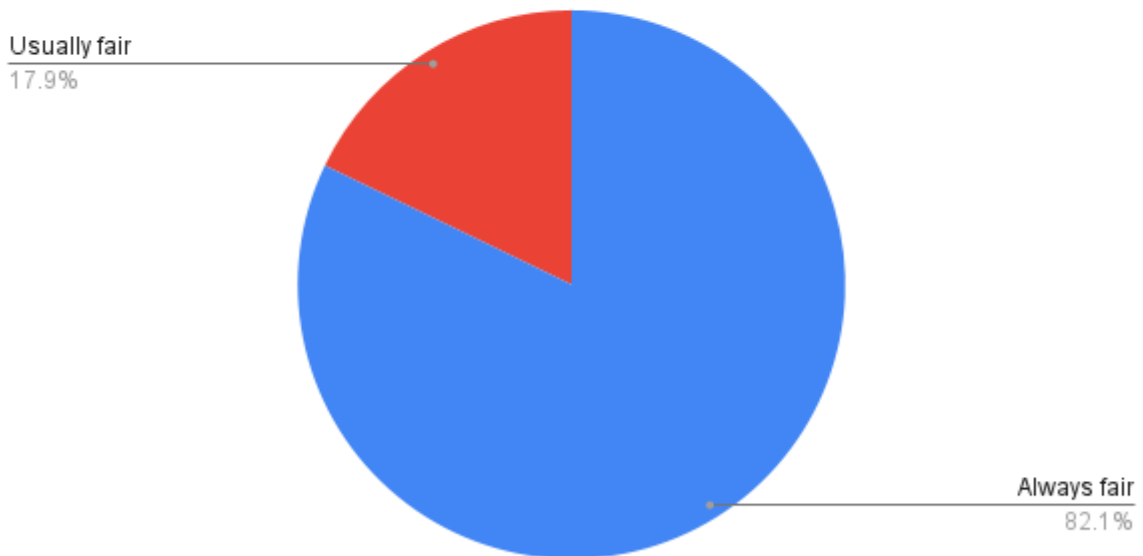
Count of 3. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as -



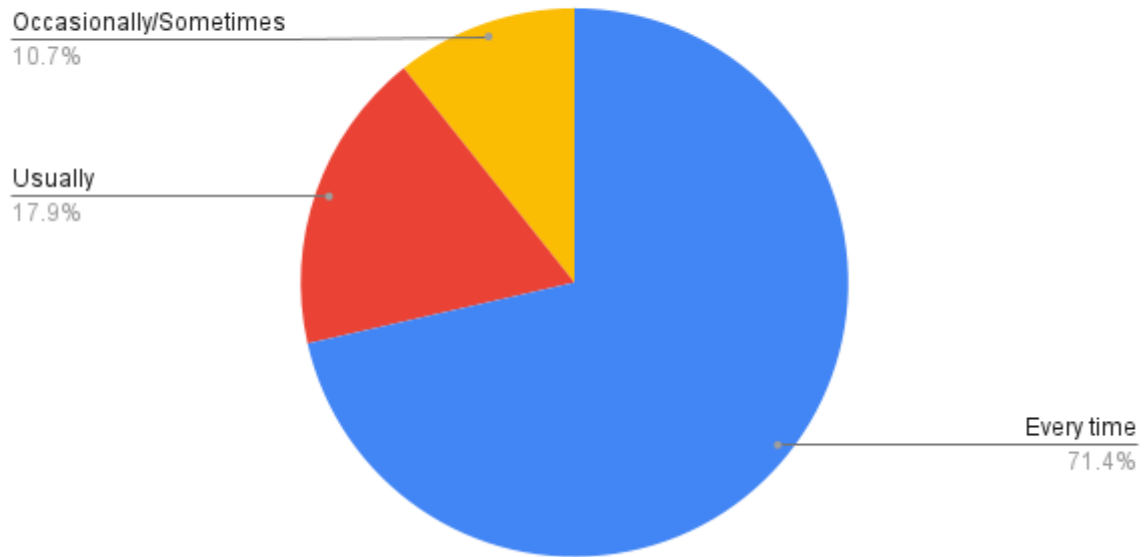
Count of 4. How well were the teachers able to communicate?



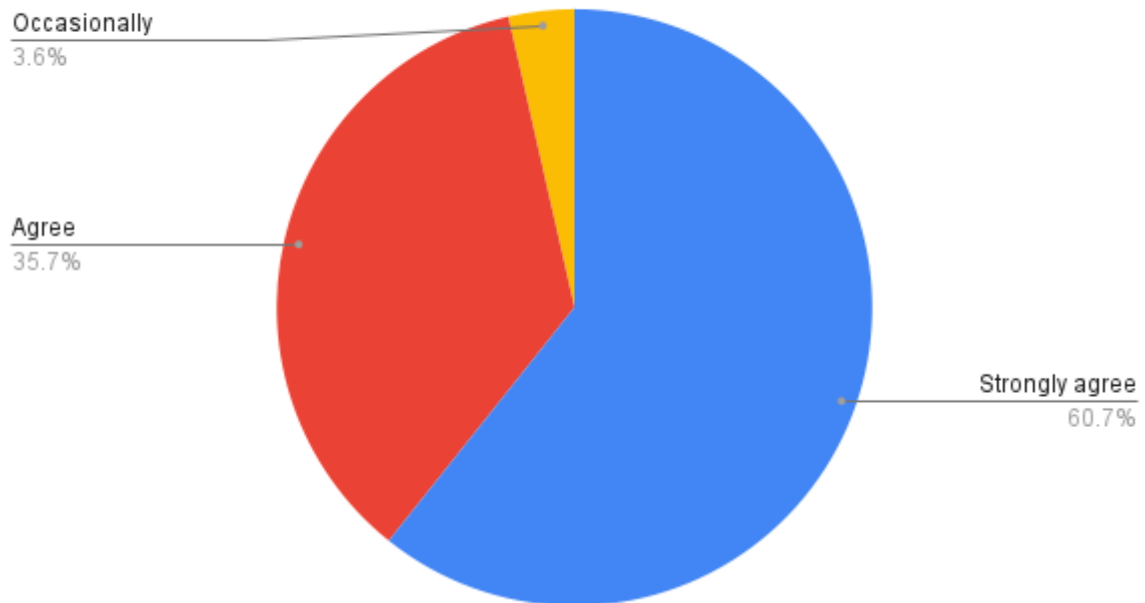
Count of 5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers



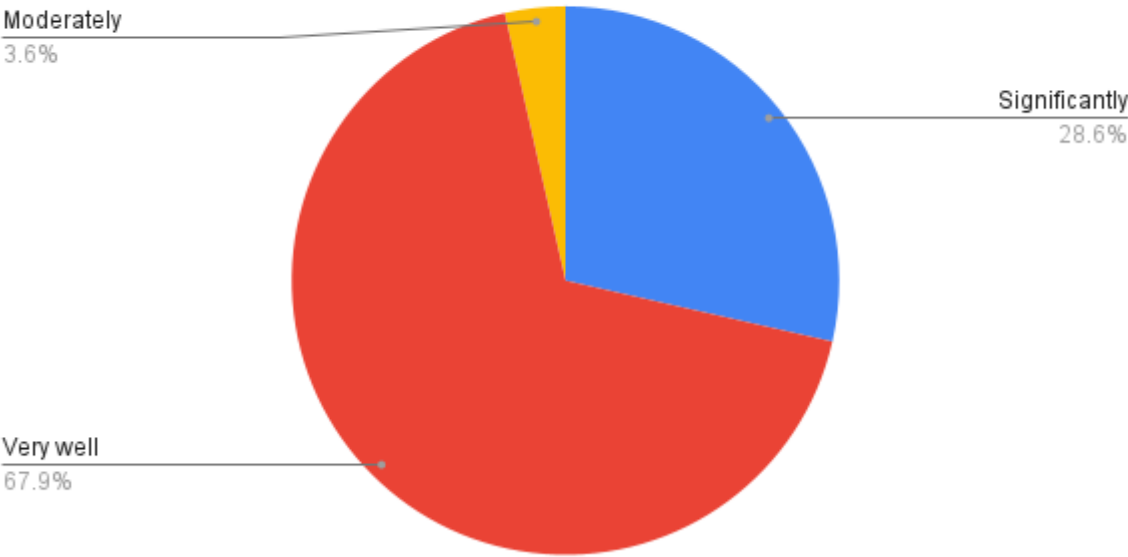
Count of 6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?



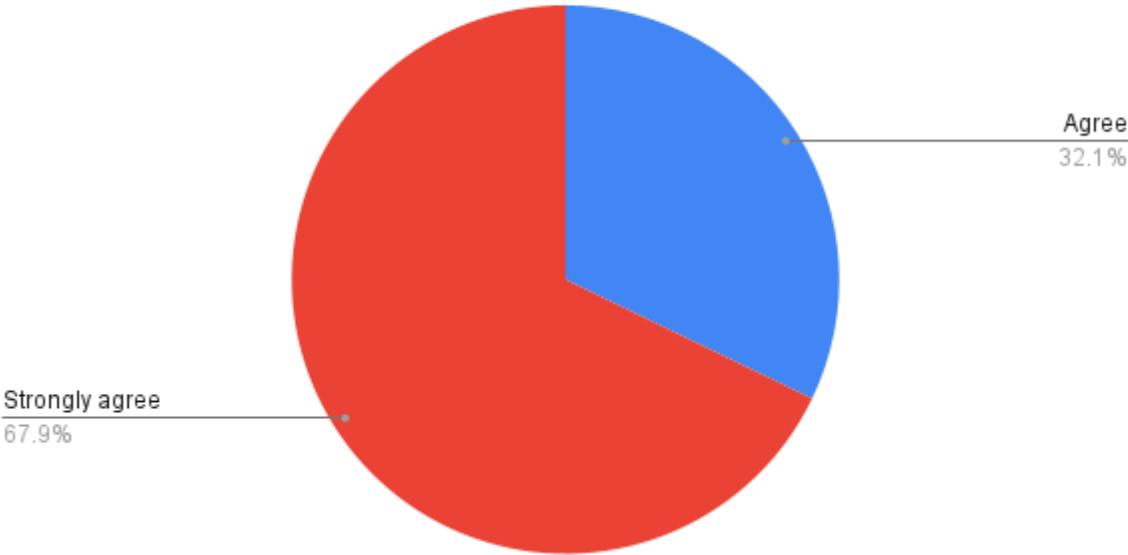
Count of 7. Teachers Gives reading and reference materials.



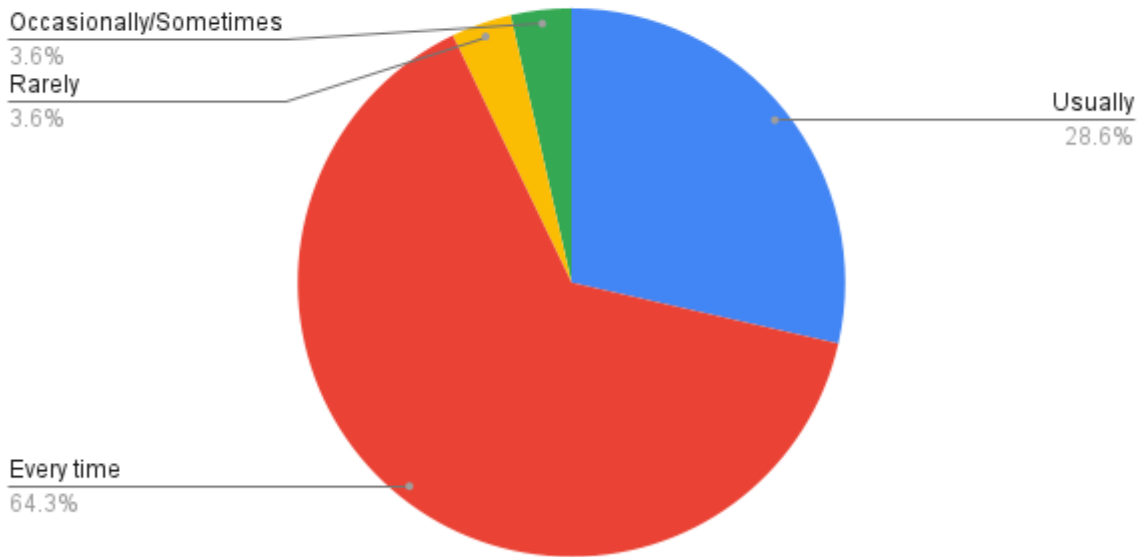
Count of 8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional



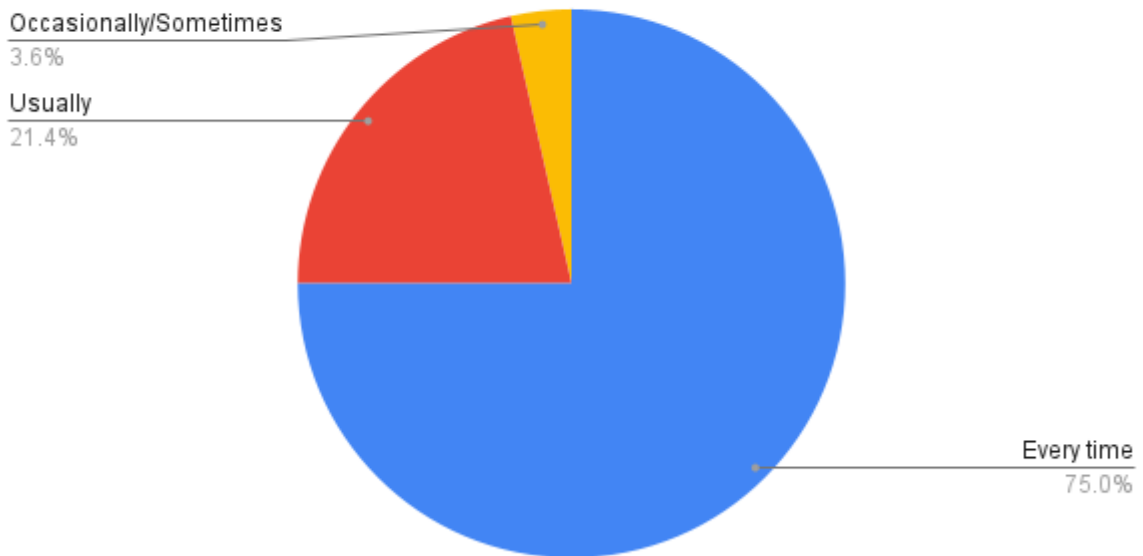
Count of 9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.



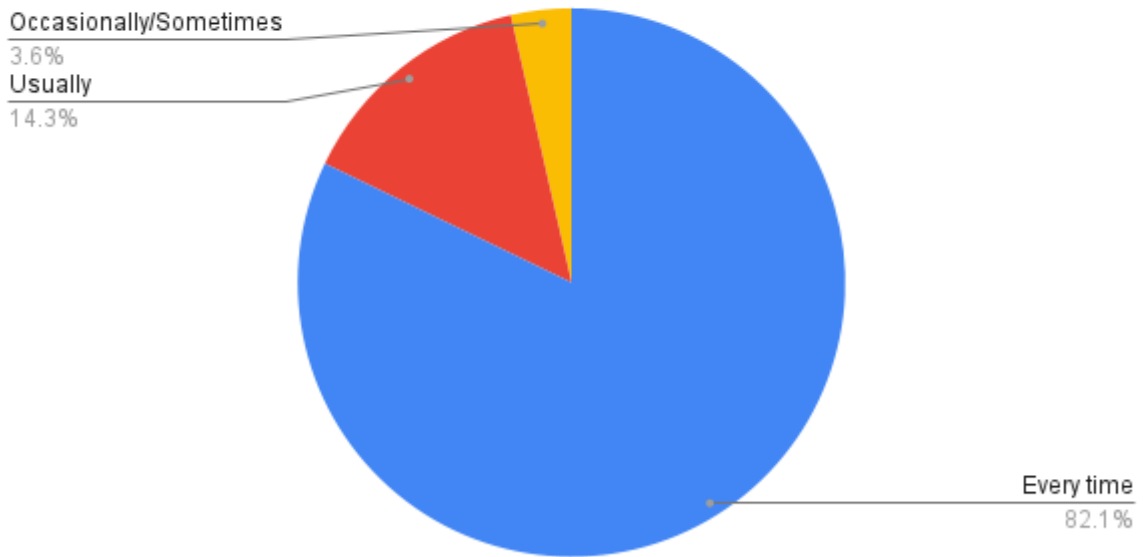
Count of 10 . Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.



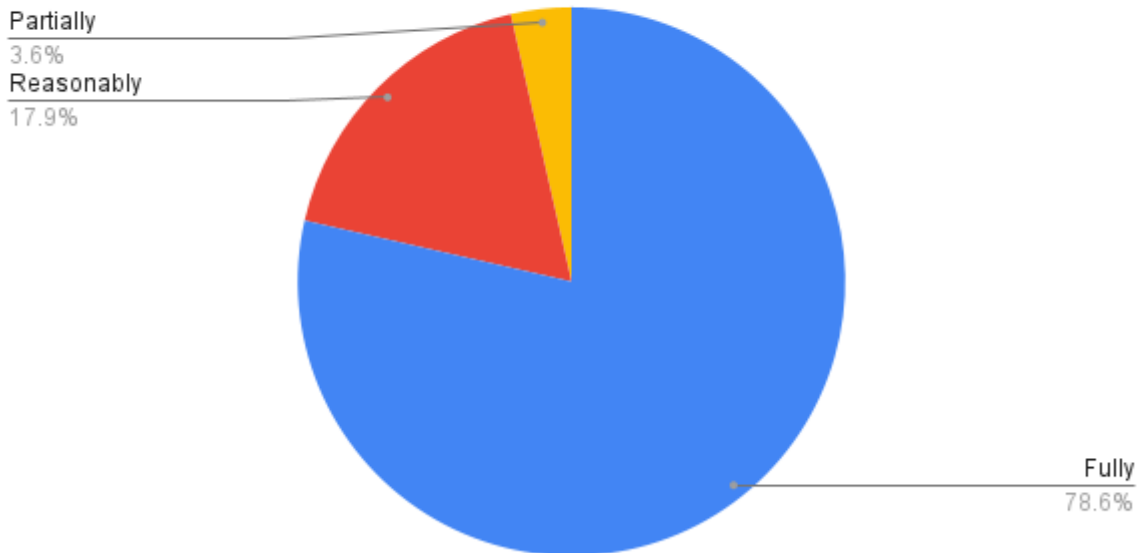
Count of 11. Your teacher does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.



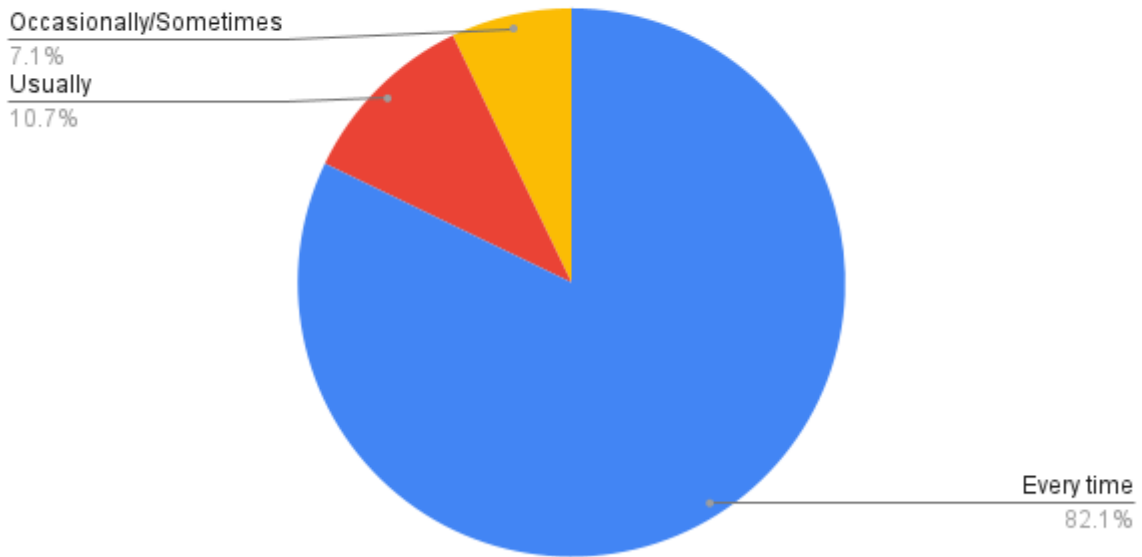
Count of 12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.



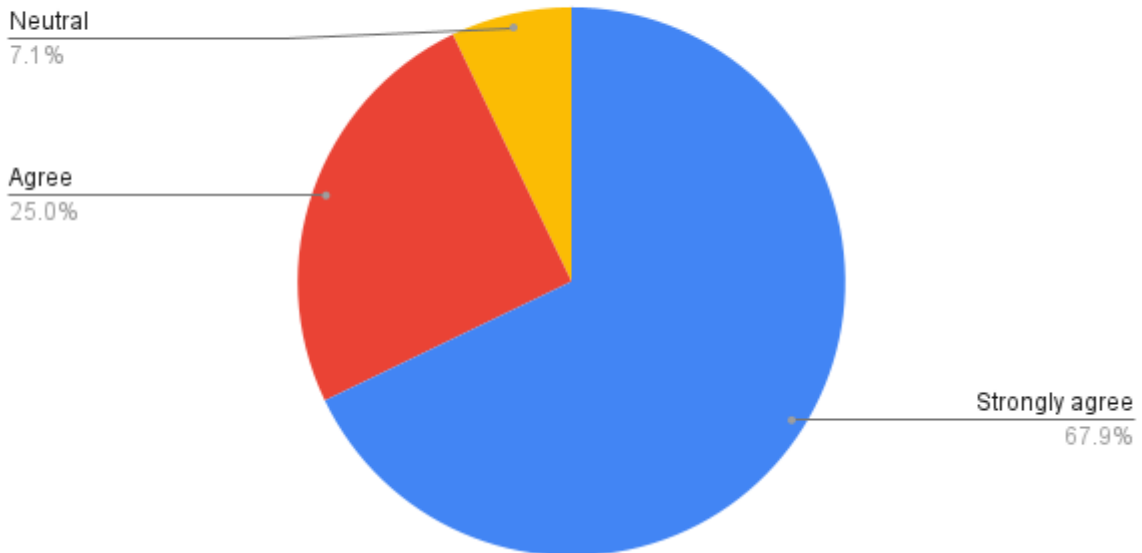
Count of 13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges



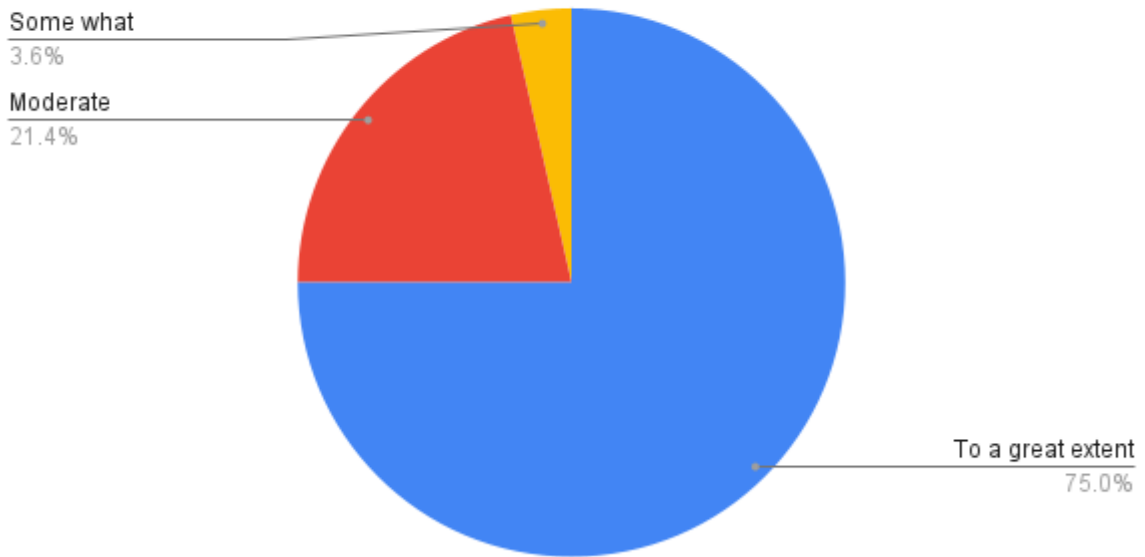
Count of 14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them



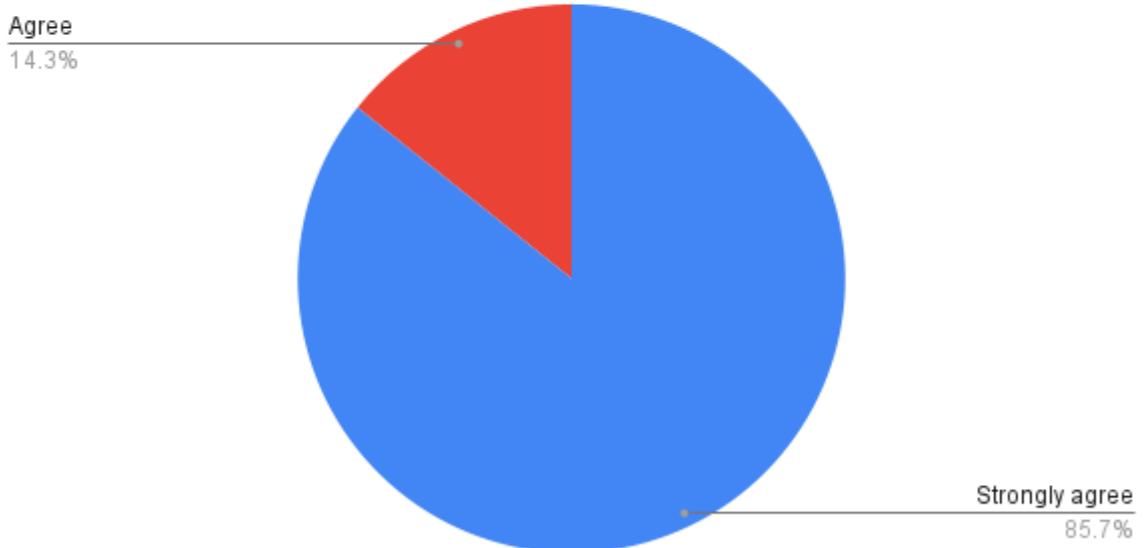

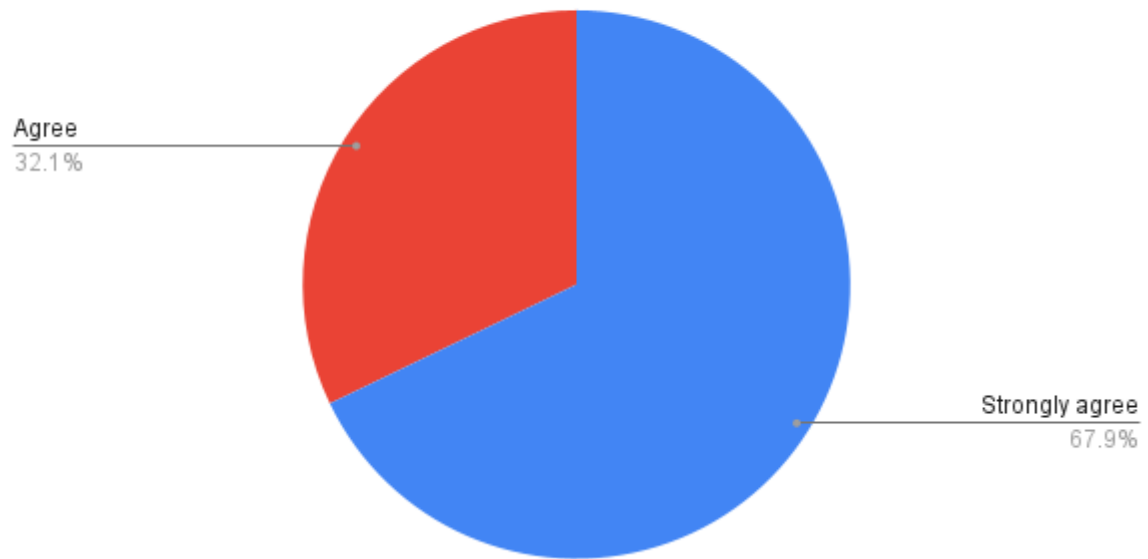
Count of 18. Teachers create a classroom environment suitable for learning.
