

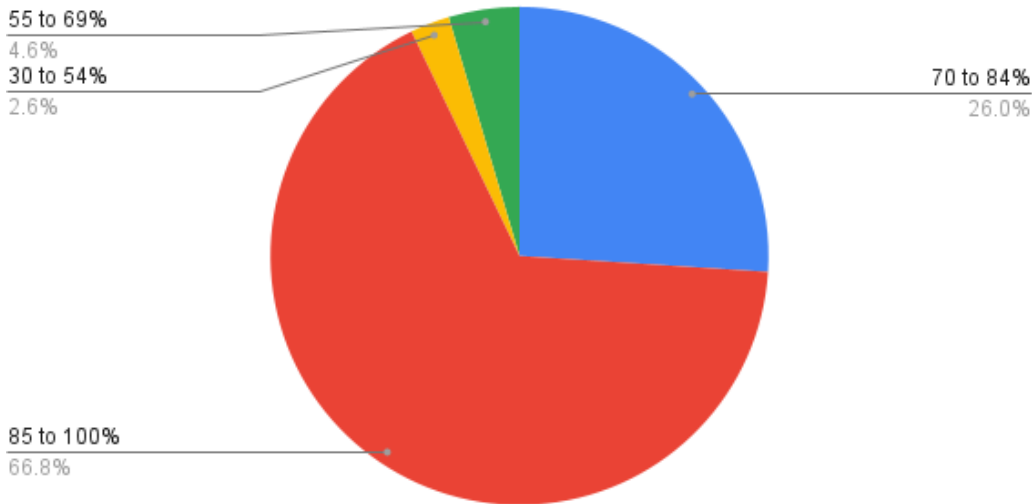

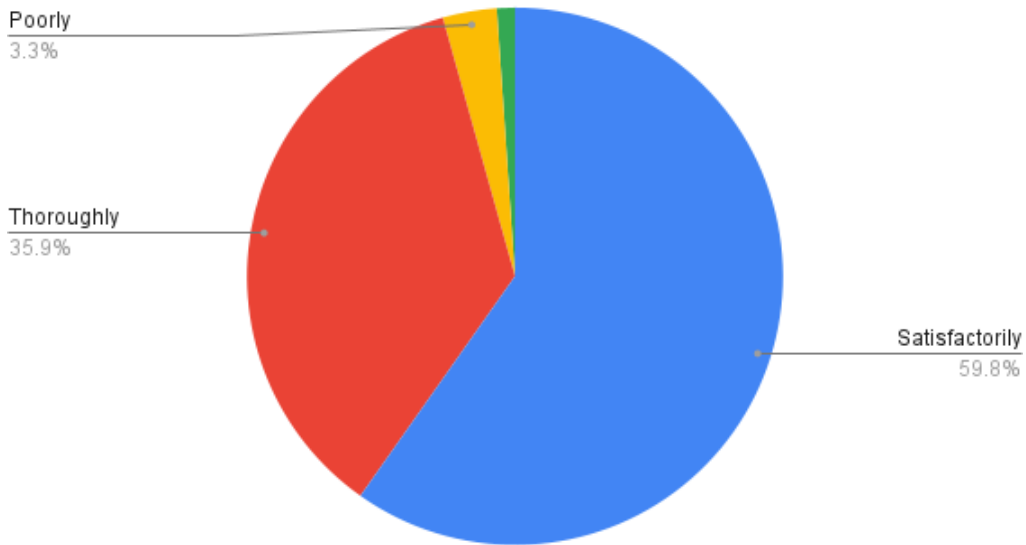
Count of 1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the Online class?



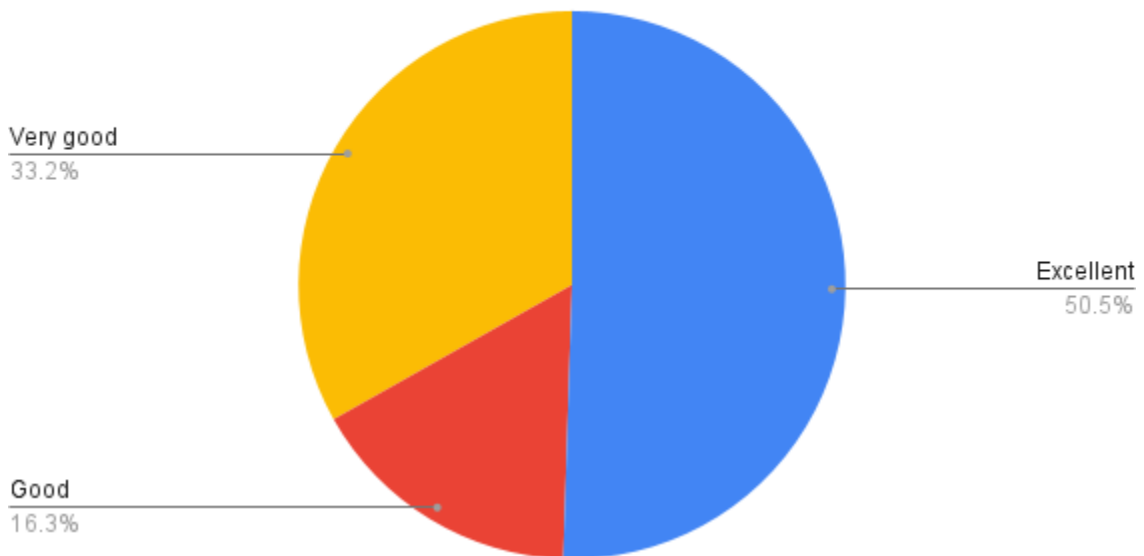

Count of 2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

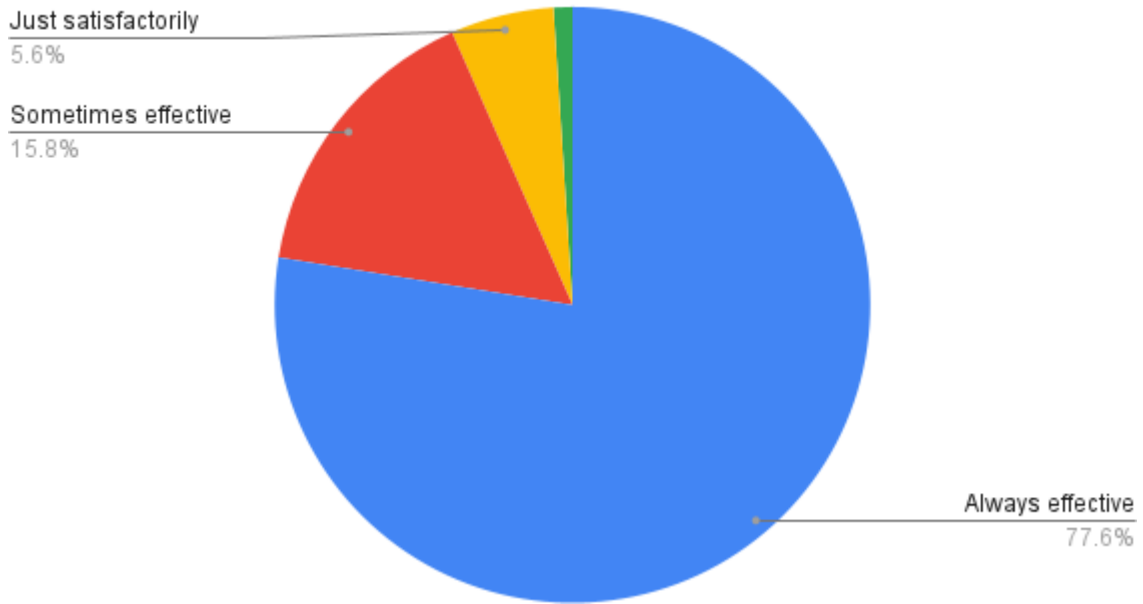


Count of 3. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as -

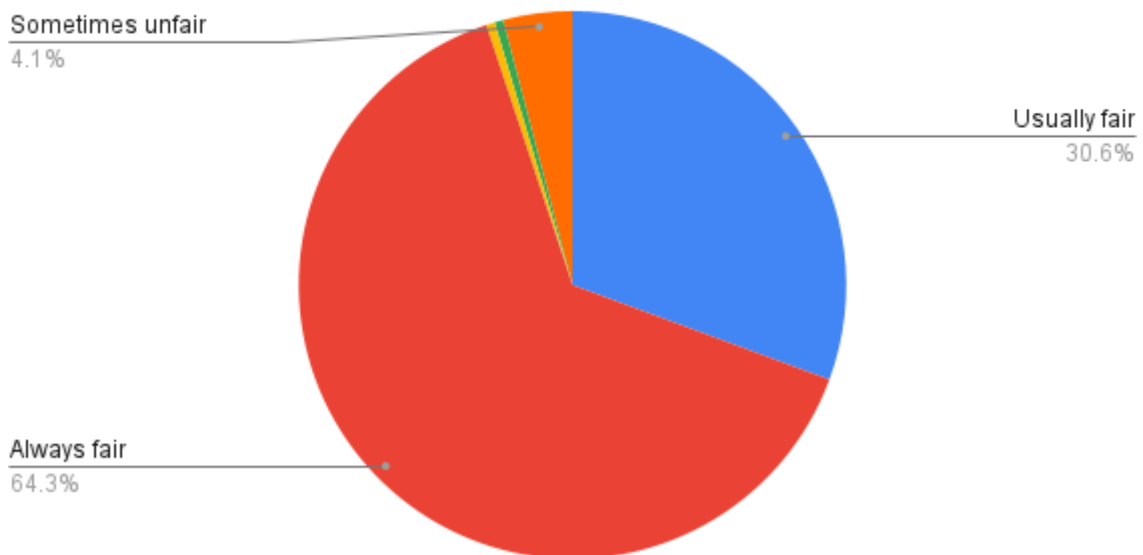

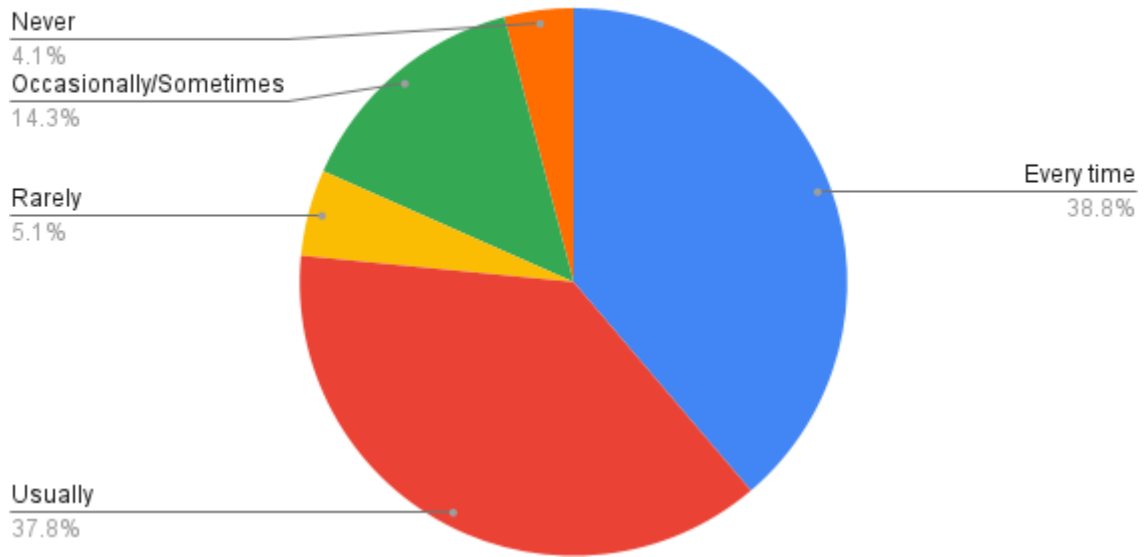
### Count of 5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers



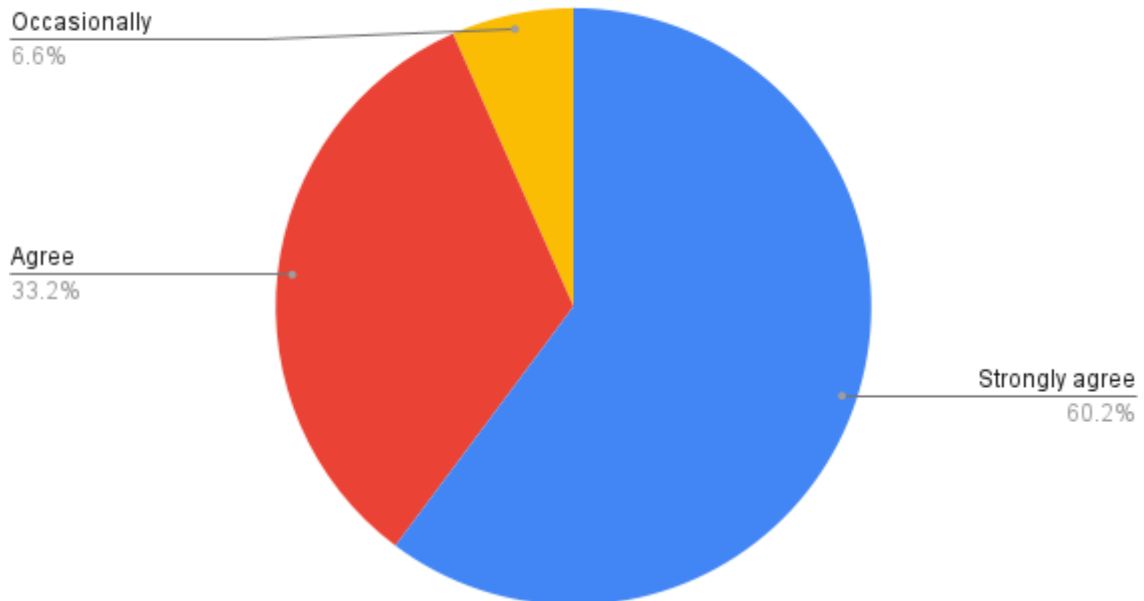

Count of 6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?



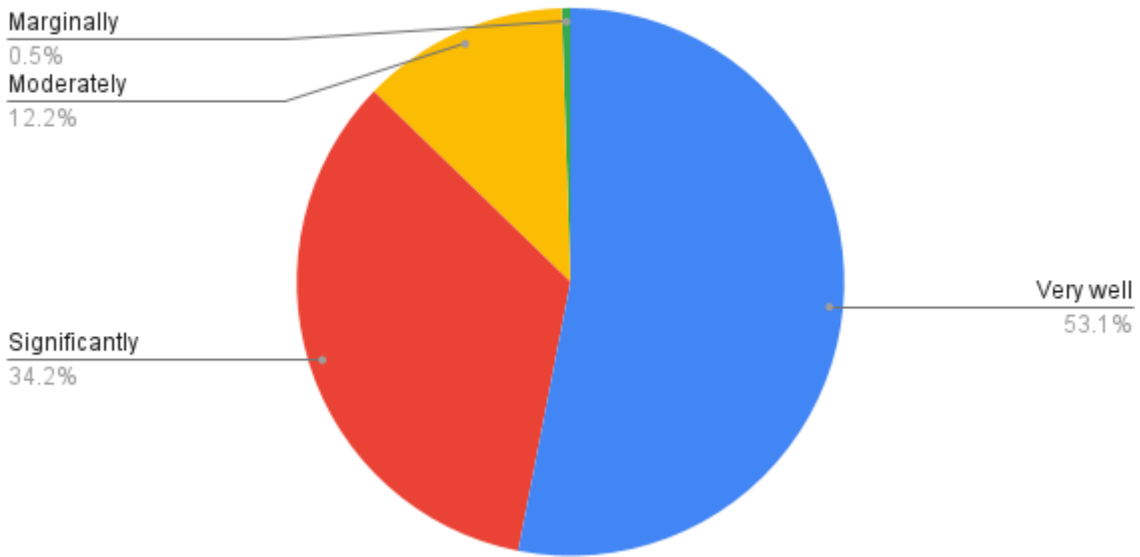
Count of 7. Teachers Gives reading and reference materials.



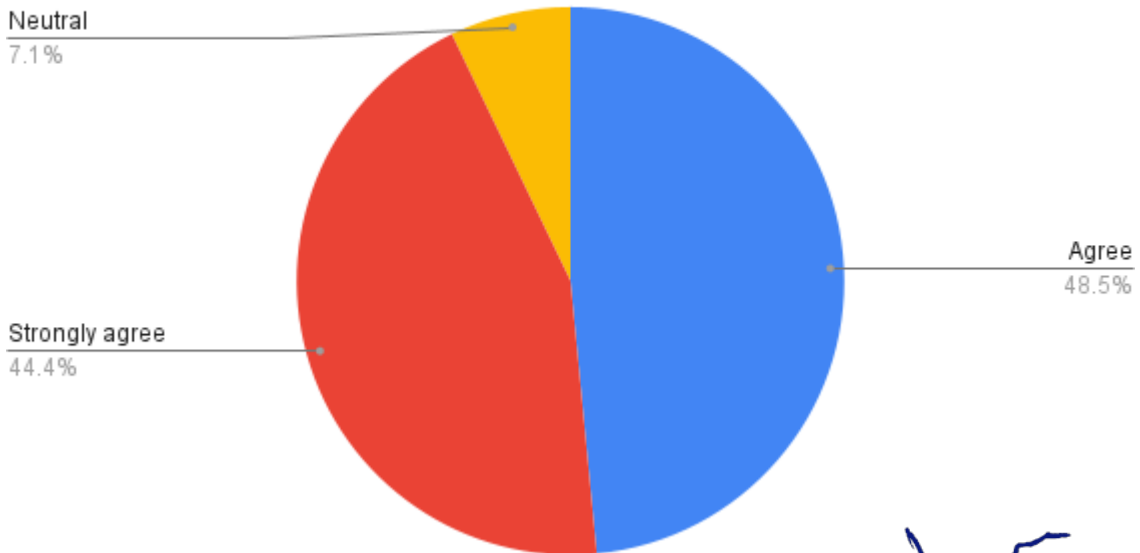

Count of 8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional



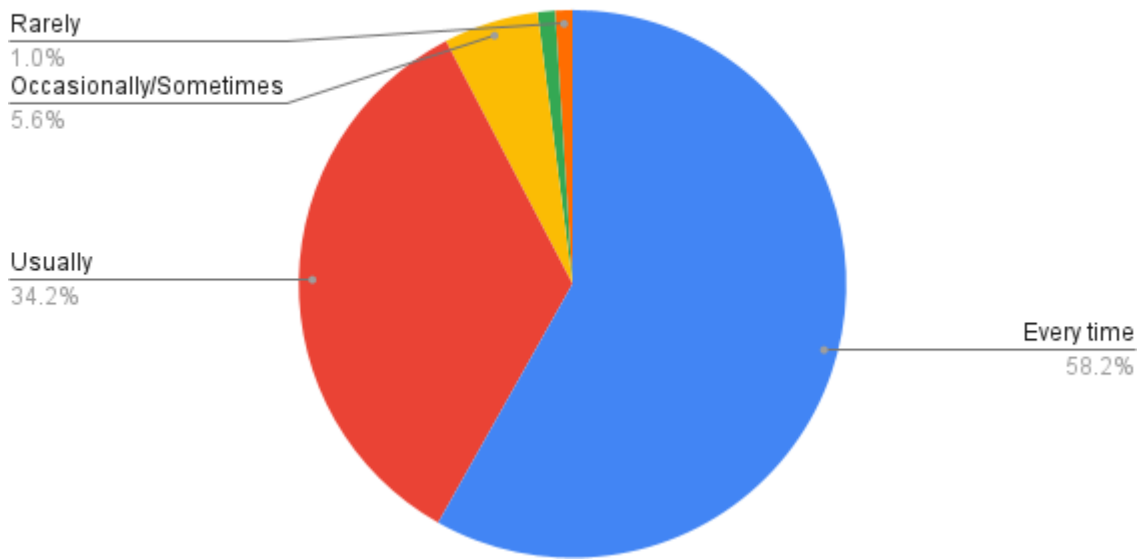
Count of 9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.



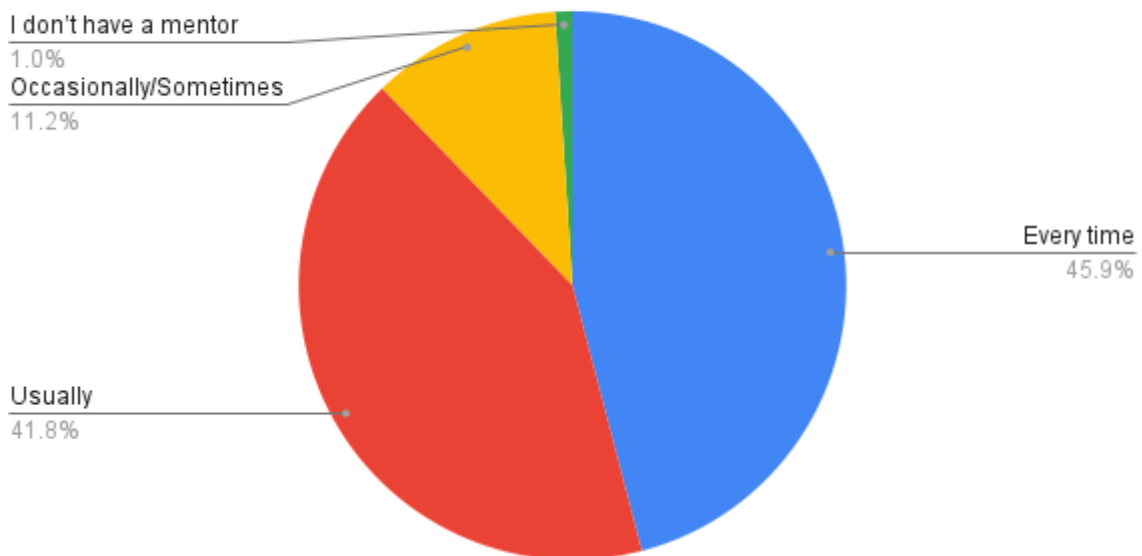

Count of 10 . Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

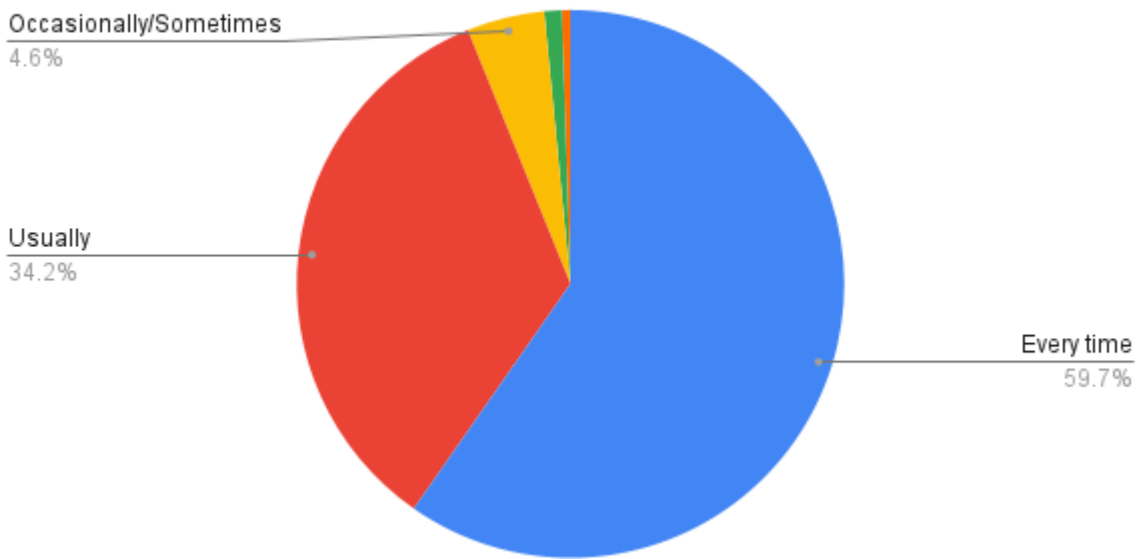


Count of 11. Your teacher does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.

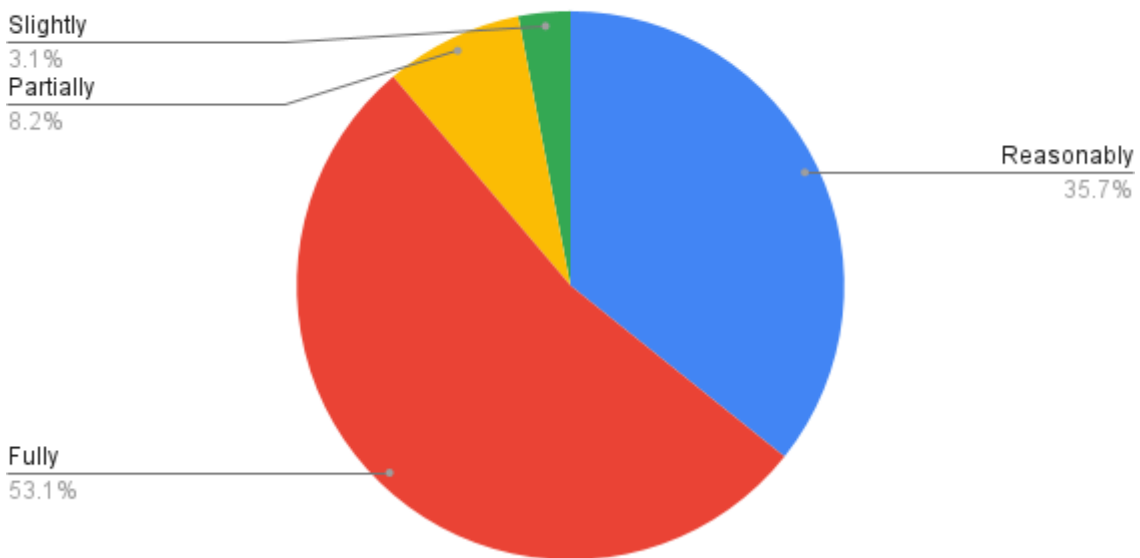

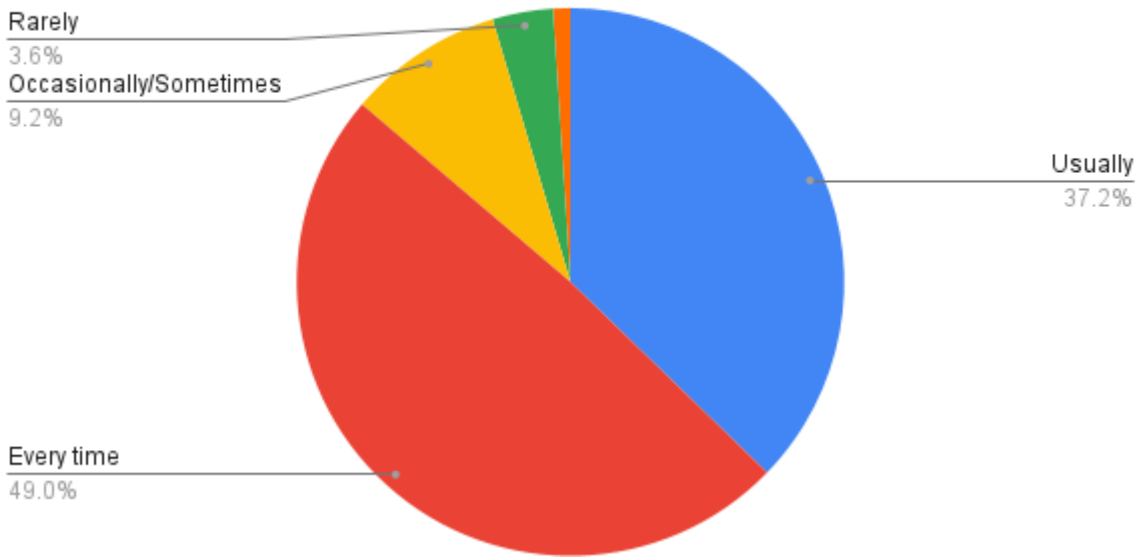


Count of 13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges

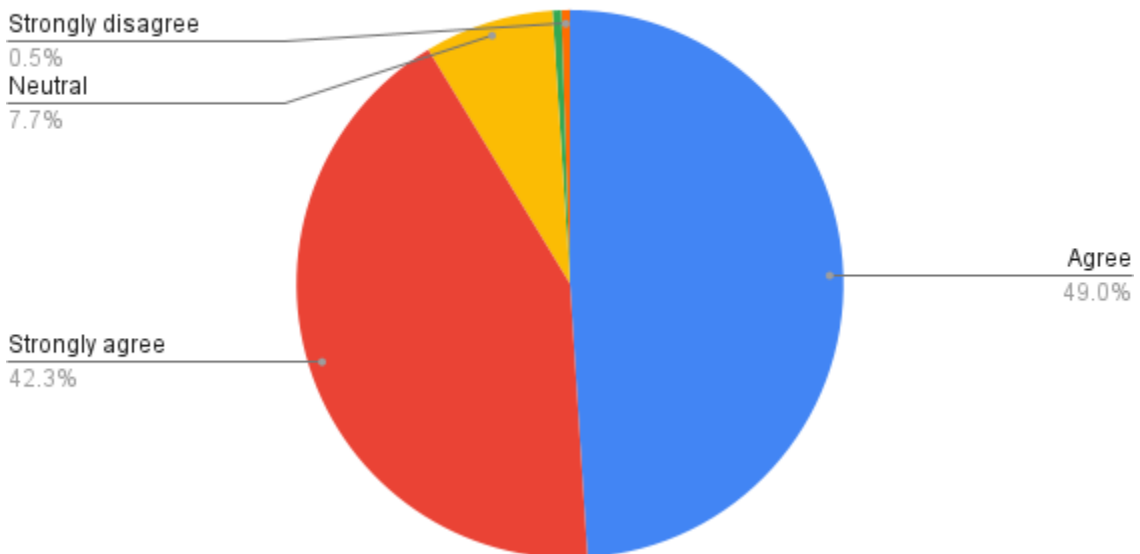

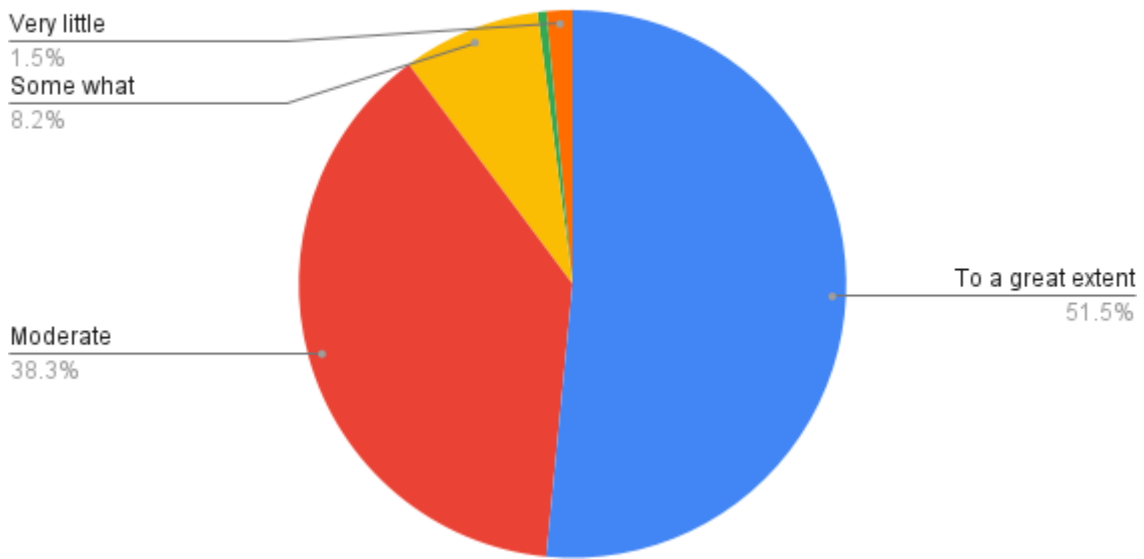

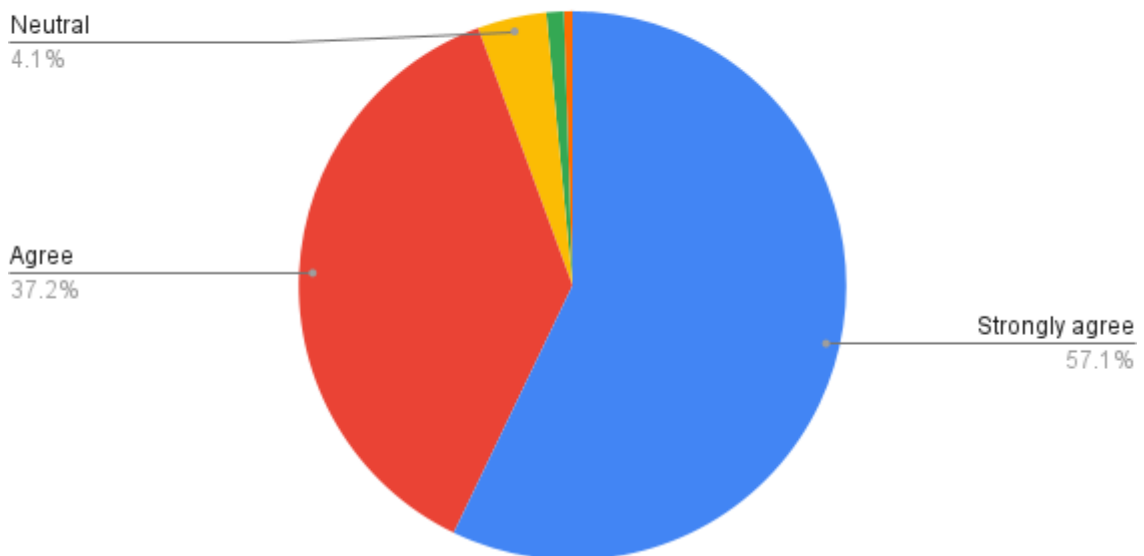

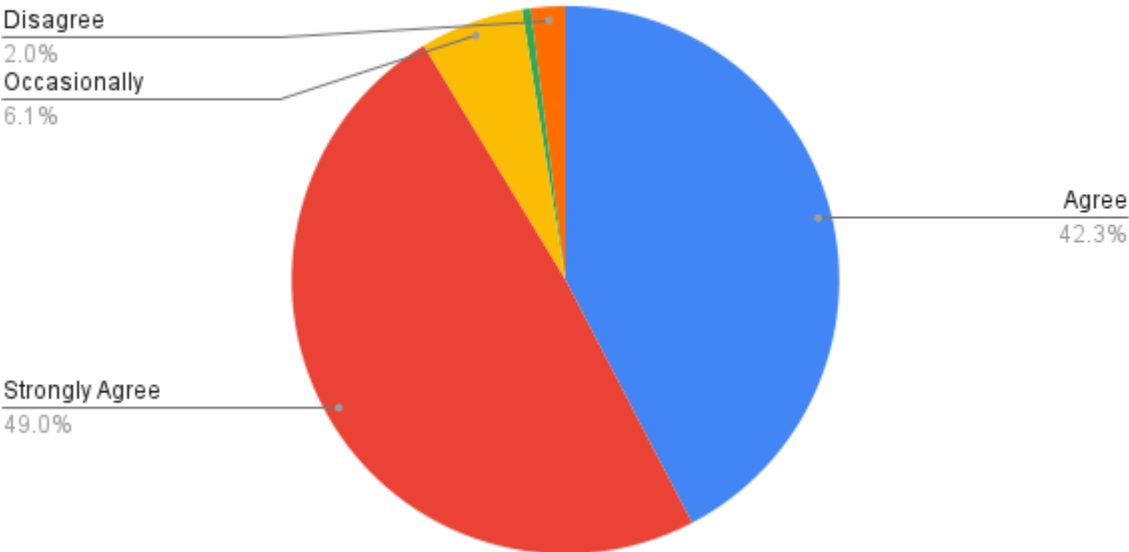

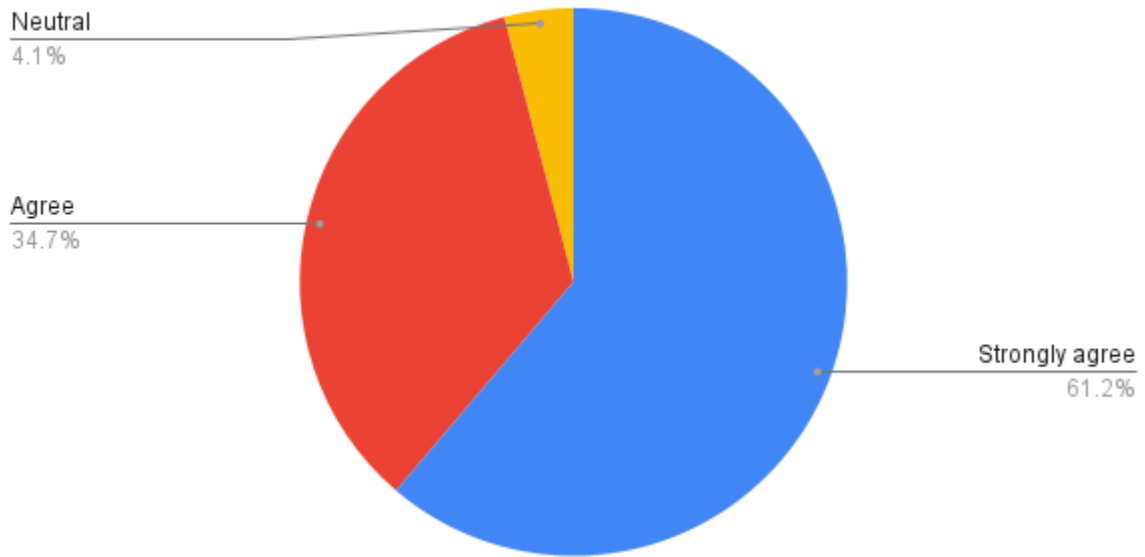
Count of 18. Teachers create a classroom environment suitable for learning.

## Summary of suggestions provided by the students during Students Satisfaction survey 2020-21 and the action to be taken to improve teaching learning process.

The data was collected and analyzed by IQAC. In general, positive feedback was received as all the stakeholders expressed satisfaction with respect to content and design of the curriculum. The relevant suggestions were listed out by IQAC. The feedback analysis was discussed with the Heads of Departments and the Director.

Area	Action taken
Enhance communication and personal attachment between teachers and students.  Teachers should be aware of students who are weak in studies.	Director informed the teachers about improving the teacher student relationship.  Director requested teachers to contact the students personally to understand the wellbeing of students and assessed their problems related to online classes.
