The University Grants Commission has been actively taking various initiatives in order to strengthen our knowledge, skill, value and research based education system in our Higher Education Institutions (HEIs). Most recently, UGC issued guidelines for the Establishment of a Research & Development Cell in HEIs. This would certainly boost up the process of developing a research ecosystem in our HEIs.

It is a well-known fact that National Education Policy-2020 focuses on integrating research in UG and PG programmes. In order to make this initiative practically implementable, UGC/Ministry of Education has devised a system so that UG/PG/Research students may receive a hands on training to become acquainted with research, research tools, techniques/ Methodologies, team work, writing, communication, publication and research ethics. This would be possible when the possibilities are created for providing research training to our graduates/postgraduates.
