ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **Central Sanskrit University Guruvayoor Campus Puranattukara, thrissur Dist, Kerala-680551** vide SRC (NCTE) order No. F.KL/SRO/NCTE/2005-2006/2333 dated **09.08.2005** for conducting **B.Ed.** course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution by consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated **19.01.2015**.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order (RPRO) was issued to the institution on **15.05.2015** for conducting **B.Ed.** course of two years duration with an annual intake of **50** students (**one basic units**) from the academic session **2015-2016**.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 381<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 31<sup>st</sup> October & 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2020 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, Accordingly, Show Cause Notice issued on **15.09.2020** to reply within 21 days. The institution vide letter dated **04.11.2020** submitted reply to Show Cause Notice.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 392<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> - 16<sup>th</sup> December, 2020 and the Committee decided as follows:-

*"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-*

*On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution **Central Sanskrit University Guruvayoor Campus Puranattukara, Thrissur Dist, Kerala-680551** for **B.Ed** programme for **1 basic unit of 50 students.**"*

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution **Central Sanskrit University Guruvayoor Campus Puranattukara, Survey No. 61 Dist, Kerala-680551** for **B.Ed.** course of two years duration with an annual intake of **50 students (one basic units)** subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
8. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc as applicable.
9. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
10. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme (s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -
  - a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution;
  - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
  - c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;
  - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
  - e. Fee charged from students;
  - f. Available infrastructural facilities;
  - g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
  - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
  - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
  - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
  - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
11. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
12. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
13. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.

**ORDER**

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993(73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 1.12.2014.

2. AND WHEREAS, the institution Rashtriya Sankrit Sansthan Deemed University, Guruvayur Campus, Puranattukara, Thrissur-680551, Kerala has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and sought for one basic unit in B.Ed.

3. AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny it is found that the institution has not maintained/revalidated the Fixed Deposited Receipts towards Endowment and Reserve Funds.

4. AND WHEREAS, it has been decided to permit the institution to have one basic unit of 50 students each subject to the institution fulfilling following condition namely,

- (ii). The institution shall submit revalidated FDRs of the enhanced values, in joint account with the SRC before 30 June, 2015 failing which the recognition will be withdrawn.

5. NOW THEREFORE, in the light of the above and in terms of Section 14(3) (a) of NCTE Act and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition Rashtriya Sankrit Sansthan Deemed University, Guruvayur Campus, Puranattukara, Thrissur-680551, Kerala for conducting B.Ed programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students one basic unit from the academic session 2015-16 subject to submission of revalidated FDRs of the enhanced value in joint account with the SRC before 30 June, 2015 and fulfilment of the conditions mentioned at II & III herein before 31.10.2015.

6. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc. as applicable

7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self- Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant

8. The institution shall maintain & update its web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-



Preamble:

The Rastriya Sanskrit Sansthan Deemed University, Guruvayur Campus, Thrissur, Kerala has been granted recognition with an intake of 100 students for B.Ed course.

The Government of India in Central Educational institution (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2007, has made separate quota for OBCs. The Central Government has decided to enhance the intake of Government institutions for providing reservations under the said Act to the OBCs.

The Rastriya Sanskrit Sansthan Deemed University, Guruvayur Campus, Thrissur, Kerala has made application on 25.09.2008 requesting for increase of intake of 27 students in view of the above Act.

The NCTE, New Delhi in its letter dated 20.06.2008 has informed to consider on priority the applications received under the above category for increase in intake.

The application submitted by the Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan Deemed University for increase in the intake from 100 to 127 was placed before SRC in its 167<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> November, 2008. The SRC considered the matter and decided to enhance the intake of the institution from 100 to 127 subject to providing infrastructural and instructional facilities as per NCTE Norms and Standards.

Hence the order.


WHEREAS in terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan Deemed University, Guruvayur Campus, Puranattukara, Thrissur – 680551, Kerala** has submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of permission for conducting **B.Ed** course with an additional intake of **27** students on 25.09.2008 as per the provisions of the Reservation in admission Act, 2007.

- Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants permission to **Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan Deemed University, Guruvayur Campus, Puranattukara, Thrissur – 680551, Kerala** for conducting **B.Ed** course of One year duration with an annual intake of **127 (One hundred and twenty seven)** students which includes the existing intake of **100 (Hundred)** students and an additional intake of **27 (Twenty seven)** students from the academic session **2008-09** under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2007 subject of fulfillment of the following conditions:

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- i. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
  - ii. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE( Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations,2007.
  - iii. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
3. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.
  4. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
  5. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
    - (i) Copy of the Application Form
    - (ii) Land and Building Particulars
    - (iii) Staff Profile
    - (iv) Recognition letter
    - (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.
  6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.


In terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, Deemed University, Guruvayur Campus, Puranattukara, Thrissur – 680551, Kerala** had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for increase of intake of **40 to B.Ed. (Sanskrit) Shiksha Shastri** Course of **one year duration** from the academic session **2005-2006**.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:
  - a) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
  - b) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
  - c) The institution has selected the Principal / Head and **seven** teachers for the said course.
  
3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, Deemed University, Guruvayur Campus, Puranattukara, Thrissur – 680551, Kerala** for **B.Ed. (Sanskrit) Shiksha Shastri** course of **one year duration** from the academic session **2005-2006** with an annual intake of **100** students which includes the existing intake of **60** and an additional intake of **40** subject to fulfillment of the following.
  - a) The institution will ensure that **eight** exclusive faculty members (Principal/Head and seven teachers) are in position for an intake of **100** students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Committee immediately and in any case before commencement of the course.
  - b) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.

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- c) The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (in case the course is started in temporary premises).
  - d) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC / University / State Government etc.,
  5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University for the appointment of faculty members and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
  6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
